SUPERVISION

They will also receive investment in the areas of character, practical ministry, and leadership.

SPECIFIC DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Participate in weekly programming on Sundays (greeting families, leading classrooms/ groups, wear Kids Min t-shirt on Sundays, facilitating large groups etc). (6:30am- 12:30pm and 3:30-7:30)
- Aid in planning and preparation for Sunday morning environments. (activities team, classroom set up) Tuesdays 1-3 pm and Thursdays 10-12 am. (with some flexibility)
- Assist follow up with First Time Guests.
- FUN, Monthly Team Outing
- Participate in weekly investment with Kelly Stewart and other Bridge staff members.

TERMS OF SERVICE

- Kids Ministry Internship is for the summer semester beginning Sunday May 28, 2017 through Sunday August 6, 2017. Each intern will be allowed two weeks off for family vacations, etc.
- Internship hours will fluctuate from week to week based on summer activities with an average of approximately 15 hours per week. Interns must be available for all Sunday services.
- Applicants must be able to commit to the entire internship from beginning to end.
