

**OVERVIEW**

ROLE SUMMARY

The Music Director is part of the Worship & Creative department that seeks to come alongside the vision of our church by facilitating a culture where people leave our Worship Gatherings saying, "Surely God is in this place." This person will work "up" with the Executive Pastor of Worship & Creative to shape team vision & strategy, and work "down" with an expanding team of volunteers and future staff to ensure they are being carried out. This person will be over all assimilation, scheduling, development, and organization of our worship team. They will lead our musicians and prioritize excellence in preparation for our Thursday rehearsal and Sunday worship gatherings. This person will build, disciple, and equip the team for future ministry, always prioritizing people over the tools needed to get ministry done.

- Ability to articulate the vision of The Bridge while executing the tasks to fulfill it

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Carry and guard culture across our worship team
- Recruit, assimilate, and develop all worship team volunteers
- Schedule worship volunteers for our Spring Hill campus
- Create lyric and number charts for weekly worship gatherings
- Assemble all Ableton tracks for worship gatherings and record necessary parts (vocal harmonies, cues, etc.)
- Set the stage for our weekly worship gatherings
- Lead our worship musicians and coach our team through our Thursday evening Grow nights
- Send out weekly song notes for each instrument
- Work with Executive Pastor of Worship & Creative to build worship sets, introduce new songs, and lead our weekly Worship Set Planning Meetings
- Other duties as needed
